The BLS Renewal Course is a video-based, ILT course that features accelerated content. It is designed specifically for providers with a current BLS Provider course completion card and allows for time efficiency while teaching both single-rescuer and team basic life support skills in both infacility and prehospital settings.
	 The BLS Renewal Course can be taught by current BLS Faculty and Instructors.
	 BLS Renewal Course materials are available on the AHA Instructor Network for BLS Faculty and Instructors to print and place in their printed BLS Instructor Manual.
